Rotary always stands against harming and displacing civilian populations and using armed aggression instead of pursuing peaceful solutions. We advocate for the observance and respect of international law. We believe in strong action to defend and promote peace, even in the darkest of times.

But we also take our position as an international, nonpolitical, nonreligious organization seriously. To respect the global perspectives and experiences of our members, and to work most effectively in our peacebuilding efforts, we do not choose sides in conflicts.

Rotary is made up of 1.4 million people in communities all over the globe who are united in our commitment to building a peaceful world. We strive to ensure that our words and actions prioritize the health and safety of our global membership and the communities where we live and serve.

Our members seek to offer humanitarian assistance to those affected by conflict, and our global reach requires that we promote peacebuilding and conflict prevention with cross-cultural, cross-border connections and friendship through Rotary.

For decades, Rotary has harnessed these connections to carry out service projects, support peace fellowships and scholarships, and establish programs like Rotary Peace Centers to help build lasting peace. Our members also take action to promote Positive Peace, addressing the underlying causes of conflict, including poverty, discrimination, ethnic tension, lack of access to education, and unequal distribution of resources

Rotary members who wish to wage peace can use district grants and Rotary Foundation global grants to support projects with other Rotary members that help refugees and displaced people, provide medical support, and more worldwide. Members can also work with or join peace-focused Rotary Action Groups, Friendship Exchanges, Fellowships, and intercountry committees. And District Designated Funds or district cash can support our peacebuilding and conflict prevention efforts.

Members and nonmembers alike can learn more about peacebuilding through the Rotary Positive Peace Academy, a free online course available to anyone with an internet connection. You can find it at positivepeace.academy/rotary

There is no denying that incidents of violence and atrocities being perpetuated around the world seem to be escalating. Global peace is fragile, and the stakes are getting higher.

Still, we know that it is possible to bring all people together to work toward a shared goal. Rotary members do so every day in every part of the world. May our ability to unify in common purpose be a spark that helps light the path out of these dark days.

As your Area Support Officer, I want to express my gratitude to the leadership team, members, and volunteers for your continuous efforts." Dear Fellow Rotarians,

I wish to take this opportunity to congratulate you for successfully navigating through the calendar year 2023, which has just ended, and for serving Rotary diligently and with devotion and commitment during the first half of the Rotary year 2023/2024.

In the same spirit, allow me to use this opportunity to wish you more of the Lord's blessings for wellness, success, wealth, and joy during 2024 and beyond.

Friendship stands as a cornerstone of Rotary, and the more people we interact with, the more friends we make. As we may recall, Rotary was started by four friends, namely Gustavus Loehr, Silvester Schiele, Hiram Shorey, and Paul Percy Harris, on the 23rd of February, 1905, in Chicago, Illinois, U.S.A. The purpose envisaged at the time was the promotion of friendship, fellowship, and networking. This explains why the first Rotary core value fellowship, is followed by service.

During the Rotary year 1919/1920, RI President Albert S Adams stated, "Friendship, the craving for which brought Rotary into existence, is the aspect that will keep Rotary a living, vital force for all time, and the very foundation of our organization."

Furthermore, I believe that no other organization can effectively bring together business and professional people in a wide variety of fields and enable them to achieve ambitious goals. We have the capacity, network, and knowledge to continue transforming communities.

Another important aspect among others is learning more about Rotary. Very often, my desire to learn more about Rotary is driven by the fact that one cannot enjoy what one does not understand. This explains our desire to continuously share the little knowledge that we have gathered during the years that we have practiced Rotary as we continue to learn more.

I believe that our value proposition is the impact Rotary makes on communities. Examples of transformational projects in Uganda are:

1. The Rotary Cancer Program was started by PDG Stephen Mwanje in 2012, funded mainly by the Annual Cancer Run which involves a huge number of participants. The Run has turned out to be the biggest Rotary-branded event in the world, with approximately 40,000 runners in Uganda during the last two years. The tangible benefit we all know is the Rotary Cancer ward at Nsambya Hospital which has tremendously increased Uganda's capacity to treat Cancer patients.

2. We have the Rotary Blood Bank at Mengo, started by PDG Emmanuel Katongole in 2014, which has increased the country's capacity to save lives of our people/patients who need blood.

3. The Mission Green Project started by PDG Ken Mugisha in 2017, when we started planting trees in various areas of Uganda and improved conservation of the environment.

4. The Maternal Child Health (MCH) Tricycle Village Ambulances (TVA) Project started by PDG Peace Taremwa and the idea of every club implementing a project.

5. The current basic education and literacy flagship project by DG Francisco Semwanga.

These projects are extremely impactful and will gradually transform our communities, serving as examples that encourage us to remain focused and inspired to do more.

My gratitude goes to the leadership of Entebbe Road Corridor, PoP Annie Ninyesiga, RC Bwebajja, Corridor Chair-President Paddy Lukwago, RC Nalumunye, all Presidents, and Rotarians in the corridor for carrving out projects as guided by DG Francisco Semwanga and his predecessor PDG Peace Taremwa, who asked clubs to execute projects as a prerequisite for the DG's Visit. The idea has positively changed how clubs operate, and the impact is felt in the whole district 9214.

Other remarkable events included the Launch of the DG's flagship project, Basic Education and Literacy at Kitala Secondary School, by RC Bwebajja, the activation of the DCA by the RC Garuga, the TRF extravaganza by RC Bwebajja. RC Mutundwe built a 3-classroom block at St. Theresa Primary School in one year with internally generated funds and grew membership by 17 Rotarians. Three clubs RC Entebbe, RC Garuga and RC Bwebajja, collaborated to sponsor the dynamic Provisional Rotary Club of Entebbe Base which boasts of an impressive cohort of about 45 prospective Rotarians. All these projects and growth make the Entebbe Road corridor shine! I can't thank you enough. The corridor has vibrant clubs with focused leadership and amazing Rotarians!

For colleagues who have not yet registered for DCA, please go ahead and register. We have approximately 2 months until the deadline. Don't miss out on the opportunity to network, listen to inspirational speakers, enjoy captivating performances by seasoned artists, and experience general happiness.



This year's accomplishments included the implementation of Solar backup and associated training. Our dedication is evident in the detailed project report submitted to the Rotary Foundation, capturing the positive outcomes achieved through collaboration and service.

Education Empowerment: A Ticket to a Brighter Future

In collaboration with RC Garuga, our club embarked on a transformative journey by constructing a three-storied classroom block for Kitala S.S, Entebbe. Launched by the District Governor on July 3, 2023, this project is a testament to our commitment to providing secondary school children with a conducive learning environment. Beyond bricks and mortar, this initiative aims to cultivate a generation empowered through education.





Advancing Healthcare: Handover of Ultrasound Scan to Nyamuyanja Health Centre IV

In collaboration with PDG Urs Herzog, our club procured and donated a Doppler Ultrasound Scan worth US\$6500 to Nyamuyanja Health Centre IV. Beyond the technological contribution, end-user training for midwives was provided, ensuring that this medical equipment is used to its fullest potential for the benefit of the community.

Cultivating a Love for Learning: BEL Project at St. Charles Lwanga Primary School Kawuku

Part of the Basic Education and Literacy (BEL) project, our engagement at St. Charles Lwanga Primary School Kawuku aimed at fostering a love for learning. Through the D.E.A.R Day (Drop Everything and Read), club members participated in reading sessions, storytelling, and empowerment talks. Donations of scholastic materials further reinforced our commitment to shaping a brighter future through education.





Medical Camp – Mubende: Bridging Healthcare Gaps

Organized in collaboration with various partners the Mubende Medical Camp on October 14th, 2023, at Madudu C/U Primary School where we provided over 3,000 people with a wide range of medical services. Through partnerships with medical institutions and organizations, we bridged healthcare gaps, ensuring the well-being of the community.



Project Wise Mission Green: Nurturing the Environment and Providing Clean Water Donating a 10,000-liter water harvesting system to Kasaana C/U Primary School, combined with the Mission Green initiative, where at least 50 fruit and medicinal trees were planted, demonstrated our commitment to environmental sustainability and clean water access. These projects, worth 4 million Uganda Shillings, contribute to a healthier and more sustainable community.









Christmas Spirit of Giving: Noah's Ark Orphanage

In the spirit of Christmas giving, our project involves supporting Noah's Ark Orphanage with essential materials and foodstuffs. This initiative extends beyond the festive season, embodying the enduring spirit of compassion and community support.

Enhancing Healthcare Infrastructure: St. Peters Sissa Church of Uganda Health Centre In collaboration with RC Akright City, our club contributed to a larger project aimed at renovating the St. Peters Sissa Church of Uganda Health Centre. The water harvesting system, donated by Buddy Group Jjanyi (on behalf of RC Bwebajja), plays a vital role in supporting the health infrastructure and immunization efforts for children in the community.

Independence Day - Blood Donation Drive: A Gift of Life

On Independence Day, October 9th, RC Bwebajja, alongside other Entebbe Road Corridor Clubs, participated in a Joint Blood Donation drive. Operating from cluster A at the former Crane Bank branch Abaita Ababiri, a total of 359 pints of blood were collected by both Mengo Rotary and Nakasero Blood Banks. This event not only symbolized our commitment to community health but also served as a collective gift of life on a day significant to our nation.



Restoring Hope at Salama School of the Blind, Mukono

The fire incident in 2022 at Salama School of the Blind, Mukono, left 103 students in dire need. In response, our club, alongside the Rotaract Club of Bwebajja and sponsors Indo Africa and Nytil, provided essential materials such as blankets, mattresses, bedsheets, clothes, books, and other learning materials. This relief effort goes beyond the physical items, extending a hand of compassion and solidarity to those who have faced adversity.

The second phase of the Adopt Bufumira Island Project on Lake Victoria aimed at holistic community development. The impact extends to improved education, healthcare, and overall community well-being.



5-Days of Wellness: A Holistic Approach to Health Awareness
